Dr. Walt Mueller is the founder and President of the Center for Parent/Youth Understanding, a non-profit organization helping to strengthen families by helping those who know and love kids to understand today's rapidly changing youth culture.



Walt has been working with young people and families for over 31 years. He is a recognized authority on youth culture and family issues, and has appeared on numerous media outlets internationally to discuss teenagers and their world. He has written extensively on youth culture and family issues and is the author of seven books including *Opie Doesn't Live Here Anymore: Where Faith, Family, and Culture Collide* and *I Want To Talk To My Teen About Movies, Music & More* and *Understanding Today's Youth Culture*. He is a regular contributor to a variety of publications including *Youthworker Journal*, *Living With Teenagers*, *Parents of Teenagers*, and *GROUP*. He also has offered commentary on Fox News Channel and CNN. Walt Mueller earned his B.A. in Sociology from Geneva College and his M.Div. from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, and his doctorate in postmodern generations from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary.
